Where is Pyongyang department store?

The Pyongyang Department Store No. 1 (Korean: ???1???) is a major retail store in Pyongyang, North Korea. On Sungri Street near Kim Il-sung Square in downtown Pyongyang, it is one of the largest retail stores in the country and is often the site of large commodity exhibitions.

Where can I buy souvenirs in Pyongyang?

Whilst there are many souvenir shops around Pyongyang, at the Kwangbok supermarket and other areas in the department store, you can pick up great North Korean snacks and goods at very fair prices. *The recommended amount to exchange is approx. 5 EUR.

Where can I buy a bike in Pyongyang?

There's a small fast food kiosk that can prepare hotdogs for KRW5000, ice-cream for KRW2000, and Korean dumplings or street food starting from KRW1000. There's also a bicycle shop with locally made bicycles (May Day models) that are available for purchase. This is where we acquired our bikes for our Pyongyang bicycle tour held every year.

Where can I use North Korean won?

It is one of the few places in North Korea where you can use North Korean Won. You can also use Won in the market in the Northeast region of Rason. In fact, since it is a local supermarket you can ONLY use Korean Won to pay for your goods. For this reason, there is a money exchange booth located within the supermarket.
